
## Tree Identification and Physiology

### How to play Kahoot!

1. Use this link:

2. It should bring you to a page that looks like this:



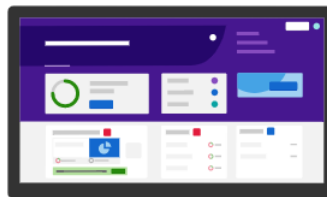

Sign up or log in to view a kahoot report after the game. You will not be able to view the report if you continue as a guest.

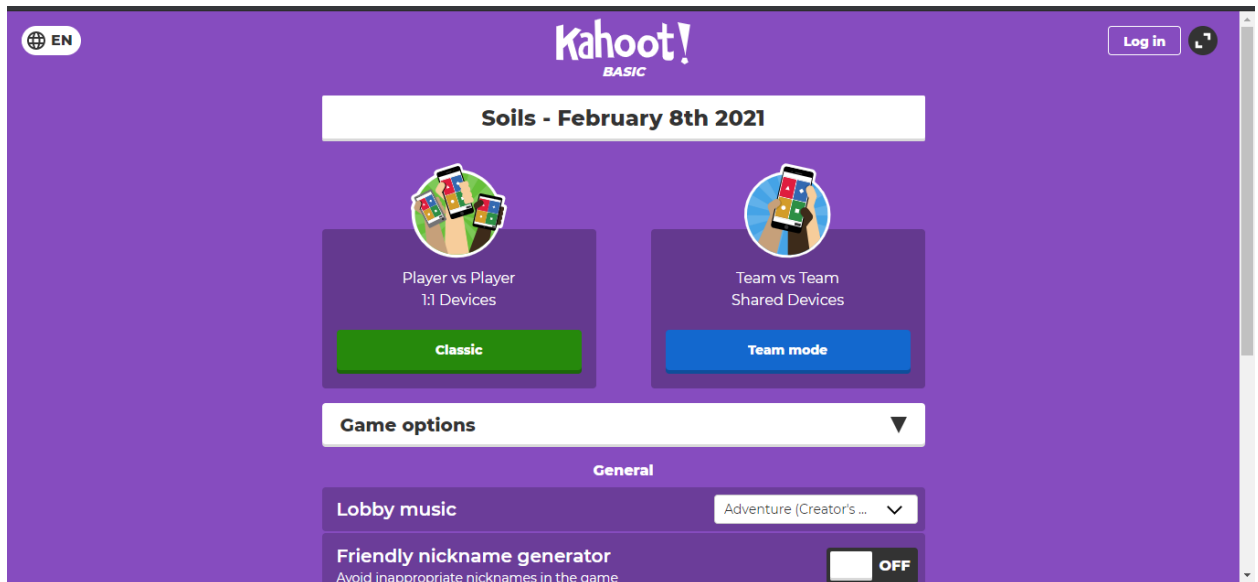

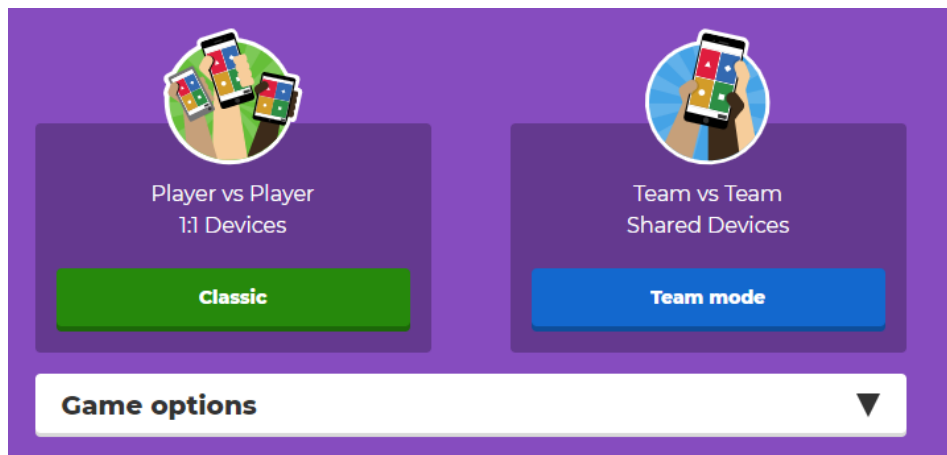

4. Once you choose how you wish to proceed, it will bring you to this screen:

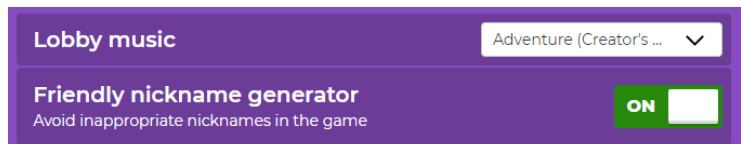


5. You can choose to play in “1-v-1” mode or “teams” mode.



6. You can change the settings to preference (such as lobby music)

- For larger groups, or younger ages, you may want to turn on the friendly nickname generator



**7. Once you choose your mode, you will be redirected to the game's lobby. Students can use their mobile device or web browser.**

- The game pin does NOT have any spaces.
- You do not need to have the kahoot app to play on your mobile device - the mobile browser is supported as well.
- On the right side, you can adjust the volume or mute it - recommended if you will be talking a lot during the presentation.
- You can see how many participants have joined on the left hand side.
- Once everyone is in, click start!
